








How Many Years Have You Been An Official




On average, how many games did you do a week?



Were you satisfied with how many games you got this year (based on your availability)?






Did you find/do you think the on-ice Shadow Program was helpful?




Overall how would you rate the Mentorship Program?






Were you pleased with the number of times you were supervised last season?


Generally speaking, did you find the information you received during supervisions helped you improve on the ice?




Generally speaking, did you find the information received from supervisors were consistent with the Hockey Canada Rule Book and Procedure manual?


Overall, how well did the supervisors communicate with you during the supervisions?


Do you review your supervisions online either through email or online portal after they are completed online?


If you had a video supervision, do you think it would be helpful?





I hope to get a chance to do the 3 man system next year


My ratings are fine, I am comfortable with the games I received however, I could do higher levels if required because of injury or short notice.


Should the CRA issue more fines (or other discipline actions) if officials do not comply with the CRA Bylaws and Constitution?


Do you feel we should be more strict on late shows? (30 min before game)

officials need to lead by example.


I think if someone thinks they will be late they message others assigned same game. If not then yes discipline

Late shows - I doubt most referees show up 30 minute before their scheduled time. I also think that assignors would be busier than they'd like to be if all officials called if their partners weren't there within 20 minutes of the start. I don't want to say that those timeframes should be "guidelines" because then nobody would follow them. It's a bit of a grey zone. Dress code - for competitive in particular this season, I saw several repeat instances of jeans being worn to the rink. I would report it as a supervisor, but not as a partner - I do not like the idea of being a snitch.




